We have a busy but exciting term ahead.....

English

In English, the children will be doing a mixture of fiction and non-fiction texts and writing. We will be basing out writing around our topic for the term. For this term, there will be a big focus on phonics with the phonics screening in June.

Maths

We will be covering various topics in this term. These topics will be covered both practically and through work in their maths books. Some of the topics that will be covered this half term will be measurement and direction. Each week, in the weekly letter, I will give you ideas how you can extend the children's learning at home through practical and fun activities.

Topic

The topic this half term is 'From farm to fork'. This topic will be incorporated into the children's science, D&T, geography, history and art. This is a really fun and exciting topic that is really practical and hands on. I have lots of fun activities planned including planting and baking.

Science

The children have really enjoyed their time in the outdoor area last term and this will continue this term. The children will be learning about maps for Geography and growing and planting for Science.

Homework

The children are asked to read at least three times a week and practice the flashcards of sounds and phonics words (alien and real words). The spellings this half term will be focusing on days of the week, months of the year and numbers one – twenty.
