It's a Splash!

This half term we will be learning about the coast looking at the Yorkshire coastline as well as island life in the Isle of Struay.

Literacy – We will start by writing poems to describe the seaside, then we will write a story set on the island with Katie Morag. Finally we will write reports about oceans and the seaside.

Numeracy – Addition and subtraction using numbers up to 100. Multiplication and division by grouping and sharing objects as well as using our clever counting in multiples of 2, 5 and 10. We will also practice our skills using money and shapes through practical activities linked to our ice-cream shop.

Topic –Using our knowledge of materials we will explore floating and sinking before making and testing boats. We will use maps and atlases to find the five oceans of our world.

Visits

To support our RE work looking at special places we will be visiting St Lawrence's Church. We will also visit Whitby looking at the Abbey, harbour and beach. A letter about this visit will be sent separately.



Super Sports

For the 2nd half term our focus will be on all sorts of different sports on the lead up to our sports enrichment week.

Literacy – We will look at lots of books about sport including annuals, magazines and biographies. We will also write persuasive texts convincing others that our chosen sport is the best ever!

Numeracy – Solving problems involving money and measures using addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will practice our measuring skills and check we can read the time to o'clock and half past times.

Topic – In science we will learn why exercise and hygiene are so important as well as naming different parts of our bodies. We will find out about some famous sporting events around the world.

P.E – Sports will obviously play a huge part this half term. However, in our lessons we will be developing our athletics skills and play simple team games using striking and fielding skills.
