### Medical

If your child becomes unwell and you need to take them to a GP, we would be grateful if you would inform us of the illness your child is suffering from when telephoning to report their absence. It is particularly important to advise us if your child is suffering from the following; chicken pox, scarlet fever, German measles, slapped cheek, shingles, as these need to be reported to vulnerable staff and pupils. There are a number of cases of chicken pox reported in school, we must ask that, if diagnosed, you ensure your child is kept away from school for the recommended period of 5 days from the onset of the rash, or until the spots have scabbed over. Thank you for your assistance in this matter.
