Building Works

Car Parking in the layby—Important message

As you are aware, there are current parking restrictions, which are enforceable by the Police, in the layby outside school. These restrictions allow the safe parking of our school buses at the beginning and end of the school day. Last week there were a number of cars parked in the layby which resulted in our buses having a great deal of difficulty trying to park. This difficulty, then in turn, caused a parking accident.

We must re-iterate that you must not park in the school layby during restriction times. We must also add that the layby may be used for buses at any time during the school day, for visits, swimming, sporting events etc. Therefore we request that you are considerate of this and if at all possible, do not use the layby to park.

We would also like to request, that in the interest of your children's safety, you do not allow them to climb on the safety barriers in the layby, thank you.
