School Lunches—Menu Changes

You should have all received the new menu for the next term, if you are unable to find it, this is now available on the school website, however there is a slight change to the dessert on week two on Tuesday, this will now be ordinary rice pudding (no coconut).

However, please note the current menu will change this Monday to; Chicken Korma or Vegetarian sausage, the jacket potato and dessert options will stay the same, and Christmas lunch will be served on Thursday, for those children who ordered it.

Please may we remind everyone that payment for lunches must be paid in advance. The amount per week (for KS2 children) is £10.50, or if you would like to pay for the half term, the amount is £69.30. Please may we also ask, that if your child is swapping between school lunches and packed lunches, please inform us, by Monday 9.30am latest, which days your child requires a school lunch that week. This can be done via the communication part of Parentpay. This information is then given to the kitchen for ordering purposes.
