Class 3 teaching arrangements

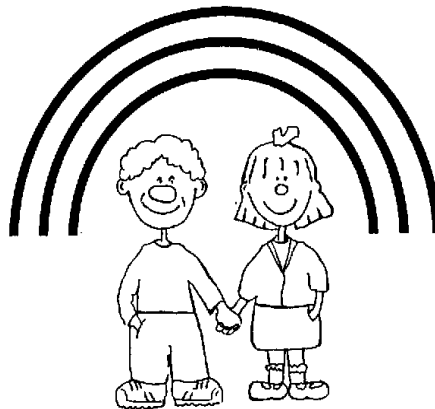
