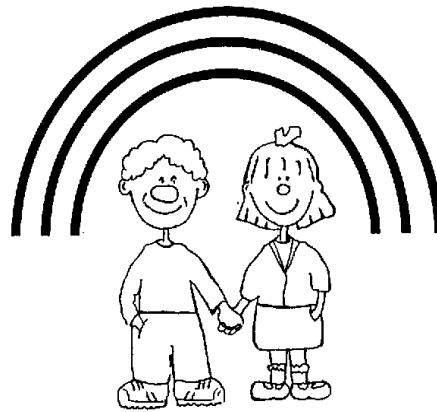

version of Parentpay. Please notify us of any meal choices via the messaging service on Parentpay. We ask that we know the days your child is staying for lunch each week by Monday morning. Please may we also remind you that the service gets incredibly busy last thing on Sunday evening and first thing on a Monday morning, therefore to avoid any issues, please ensure your payments have been made prior to these times wherever possible. It may also be useful to know that the minimum payment of £10.50 only applies to school lunches. When this minimum payment is made, the amount carries forward until it is used up and will even be carried forward into a new term and academic year if necessary.

As we have also indicated on our previous newsletters, from September we will no longer be able to accept cash or cheque for school lunches, visits, swimming etc. Parentpay can be accessed via the internet on pc's, laptops and a new mobile app is due to be launched later this term. If you will have difficulty using Parentpay in September, you must contact the school office staff, as soon as possible, to discuss this further. Please note that those people who have not registered for Parentpay will be receiving a letter with details of how to log on to the service with username and password details. If you have any queries about Parentpay, please do not hesitate to contact a member of our school office team.
