## Congratulations

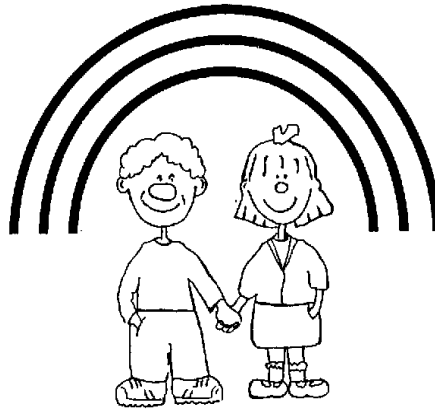
