

Scaled Scores 2017

In the Y6 assessments a child's raw score on a test is converted into a scaled score where 100 means a child is achieving the National Standards. All the children's scaled scores are added together and divided by the number of children in the class to find the average scaled score. This is then compared with the average scaled score of all schools. Below is a table of this information.
